

NETUPDATE4 INSTALLATION IN WINDOWS 8

By default Windows 8 doesn't allow to install unsigned drivers. For this reason, in order to be able to install NetUpdate4 (and all the drivers) please follow this procedure:

- 1 Move your mouse to the bottom-right corner of your screen and click over the **"Settings"** button.
- 2 Select **"Change PC Settings"**.
- 3 Click on the **"General"** category.
- 4 On the right panel, scroll down and click the **"Restart now"** button located on the **"Advanced startup"** category.
- 5 Once restarted, a screen titled **"Choose an option"** appears. Click **"Troubleshoot"** tile.
- 6 Select **"Advanced options"**.
- 7 Select the **"Startup Settings"** tile then click the **"Restart"** button to reboot the computer again.
- 8 On the Startup Settings screen, tap the F7 or 7 key on your keyboard to select the **"7) Disable driver signature enforcement"** option. Windows 8 will immediately boot to its typical lock screen. Sign into Windows 8 as you normally would — everything will look the same, except Windows will no longer demand driver signatures until you next reboot.
- 9 Install now NetUpdate4 by launching the NU4Setup_vxxx.exe file and follow the instructions showed on the installation wizard. This procedure will automatically install the drivers for the meters of the product ranges **"TVEXPLORER HD"** and **"HD RANGER"**.
 - In the case of the meters of the product range **"TV EXPLORER II"** you will have to manually download the drivers from the website www.promaxelectronics.com and install them according to the instructions supplied with the drivers.
- 10 Reboot Windows.
- 11 Now you can launch and use **NetUpdate4**.

REMARK: In Windows Vista, Windows 7 and Windows 8 it is necessary to launch NetUpdate4 with administrator privileges, in order to allow the software to communicate with the meter through the USB. Therefore, right click over the **NetUpdate4** icon and select **"Run as administrator"**.
